

Jesus Sent

John 20:21

Every Christian is “Jesus-sent”—to share His purpose.
So, we must see ourselves as “sent ones.”

The great purpose of Jesus is to give people “life to the full.”

*“I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.”
(John 10:10)*

Three great realities of the Jesus Life:

1. Jesus came—to give His life for us...
2. Jesus comes—to give His life to us...
3. Jesus is coming again—to fulfill every promise of God for “*life to the full*.”

For us, this means...

The purpose of Jesus for people to have “*life to the full*” must be our purpose also.

Jesus is our pattern—and Jesus was sent.

- The Father sent the Son
- The Father and Son sent the Spirit
- The Son and the Spirit send us

Just as He was sent—so Jesus sends His followers.

“As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.” (John 20:21)

To where am I “sent”? Who has God “sent” me to?

Being blessed by God, empowered by the Holy Spirit and sent by Jesus is what makes ordinary life become supernatural and life-changing.
