3. "through faith in Jesus Christ" (22)

²⁵ *God presented him as a sacrifice of atonement, through faith in his blood.*

4. "to all who believe" (22)

God's "righteousness" for salvation is...

7. "to demonstrate His justice (righteousness)"—now (25)

5. to be "justified freely by His grace" (24)
