**Discover Your Natural Style For Sharing Jesus**

What was your view of evangelism before Sunday's message on Contagious Faith, and how was it affected by what you heard?

Can you relate to the idea that evangelism sometimes feels unnatural or forced? Can you share a story of a time when it felt that way? Based on your learning, how might you have approached that situation differently?

Considering Sunday's message, which of the five faith-sharing styles would you say would be your most natural approach? (For review, here are the five styles: Friendship-Building, Selfless-Serving, Story-Sharing, Reason-Giving, and Truth-Telling.)

Now that you've identified your top faith-sharing style, what steps could you take to develop it further? Also, where could you use that faith-sharing style in the next week or two?

When using your faith-sharing style to point people to Jesus, can you think of ways to strengthen your influence by partnering with someone with one of the other four styles? Which style would best supplement your own? Can you name someone in your circle who you think has that style?

Who comes to mind when you think of sharing your faith? (Give their first name and a brief description of the relationship.) Pair up with someone in your group, share the name of the person you're each thinking of, and pray together for each person — asking the Holy Spirit to draw them to Christ (and to use you in the process).
