Jesus' Cares: Week Nine

1. Nicodemus (male, religious teacher, educated, powerful, insider) and the Samaritan Woman (woman, lacking power, outsider) are very different, yet Jesus expresses care for them both. Who do you relate to more? And why?
2. Jesus cares about people. Which people (groups, neighborhoods, Sounders fans, etc.) do you struggle to care about?
3. What does being "born again" mean to you?
4. How have you experienced Jesus' care for you?
5. Which invitation most resonated with you (Come to Jesus like Nicodemus, accept that Jesus gave his life for you, figure out where you have to go because of care for people)? What is your next step in that invitation?
6. "For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned..." Take some time to pray the truth that Jesus doesn't bring condemnation but life. Pray a blessing of light and life over each other and reject the condemning thoughts and patterns.
