



## Discussion Questions Jesus & The Ten Commandments Week 2: Our Issue with Idols & Images

1. What are some images that represent people or things you highly value?
2. What is the power (good & bad) of images in our lives?
3. Read **Exodus 20:4-6**  
Have you ever considered this commandment before, and if so, how did you tend to think about it?
4. In our message this week, Pastor Dave said, "Idolatrous images are often what we use to define God how we want him to be, rather than who He truly is?"
  - How & with what images have you seen people do this in our culture?
  - How are you tempted to do this?
5. Idolatrous images may highlight certain aspects of who God is but often leave others out. What are the aspects of God's character you enjoy and readily embrace? What are the aspects you struggle with?
6. Idolatrous images are also often present when we want to use God to get or keep something we want.
  - How do we see this in the Israelites in the story of the golden calf from Exodus 32?
  - What do you really want (or expect) God to give you because you worship him? Is there an image that represents this in your life?

7. What else from this week's message stood out to you?
  
8. What will shift, change, or be reinforced in your life due to studying the 2nd Commandment?
